| Mission Control  | Coordinates launch activities and ensures safe launch operations.               |
| Recovery         | Works with the US Coast Guard to recover the rockets and their payloads.        |
| Tracking         | Tracks the rockets flight and informs recovery teams of splashdown coordinates. |
| Weather Balloons | Assists in payload preparation and launching of a high altitude balloon.        |
| Video Production | Works with video crew to record launches.                                       |
